Dear QM 2008 Authors,

The proceedings of Quark Matter 2008 will be published as a special issue of *Journal of Physics G: Nuclear and Particle Physics* and we are very eager to receive your contributions. The issue will contain refereed plenary and parallel session write-ups. (Please note this issue will not contain any poster contributions, which will have a separate proceedings - see the conference registration desk for details).

Contributions will be refereed to the journal's usual high standards of scientific quality, but taking into account the conference nature of the issue. This means background papers and articles reviewing progress in an area will be considered more favourably than normal for regular research papers. However, articles which have already appeared in substantially similar form in the peer-reviewed literature cannot be considered. In case of doubt, please contact the Publisher.

Page limits

There is a strict page limit for plenary contributions, of 8 journal pages (B5 sized), and 4 journal pages for parallel sessions. Please note that these limits include space for figures and that articles will be reformatted on acceptance into our journal's style. Please do not exceed these limits as they are important to control costs and to ensure the issue can be bound in a single volume.

Submitting your contribution

The deadline for receipt of contributions is **27 April 2008**.
If we do not receive your article by this deadline we cannot guarantee its inclusion in the special issue.

What files to submit

The submission process is very simple and will only take a few minutes to complete. When submitting it is important that you send us your original source code. We can accept any common variant of TeX or LaTeX. We can also accept MS Word files. Please note that PDF or PS files of your text are not sufficient on their

own, as these file formats cannot be used in our production process. Please remember to include your figure files preferably in EPS, TIFF or PDF format. Contributions must be written in the style of a research article, rather than as a transcript of a talk. More detailed guidelines on file formats and style files, etc can be found at authors.iop.org

How to submit online

The simplest and recommended way to submit is through our online submission form at: authors.iop.org/submit
Please fill in all fields on the submission form. Most fields are self-explanatory, but to expedite the processing of your contribution, please take extra care to ensure that the following fields are completed as follows:

Journal: *Journal of Physics G: Nuclear and Particle Physics*

Article type (drop down list): Special issue article

Special issue details: QM 2008 contribution

You can then upload the required files by following the instructions on the form. If you have successfully completed the submission process, you will receive an acknowledgement e-mail within a few hours.

How to submit by e-mail

An alternative is to send your manuscript and figures via e-mail, as attachments. Please send it to jphysg@iop.org and ensure the subject line reads "**QM 2008 contribution**" so that your article can be easily identified.

Whichever method you use to submit, you will be sent an acknowledgement e-mail within a few days to confirm that your files have been safely processed.
